House Committee to inquire into the Telecommunications Amendment (Enhancing Community Consultation) Bill

The House of Representatives Infrastructure and Communications Committee is conducting a new inquiry into the **Telecommunications Amendment (Enhancing Community Consultation) Bill 2011**. The Bill was introduced to the House on 19 September 2011 and referred by the Selection Committee on 22 September. The Bill proposes 12 amendments to the Telecommunications Act 1997.

The Committee is now inviting submissions from interested parties on the details of this bill.
