



NBN Co to discuss NBN rollout performance

The Joint Committee on the National Broadband Network will tomorrow (Thursday, 13 October) resume its hearing with NBN Co on the performance measures associated with the rollout of the National Broadband Network (NBN), as it continues its six monthly review.

Committee Chair, Rob Oakeshott said "The committee welcomes the opportunity to examine the Shareholder Minister's first release of qualitative and quantitative NBN rollout performance information for the last financial year."

"The committee will examine the Telstra and Optus deals more closely and the associated regulatory and competition issues, as well as issues surrounding pricing of the NBN product at hearings in Sydney on 24 and 25 October" Mr Oakeshott said.

The committee will present its second report to the Parliament by the end of 2011.
