## INDIGENOUS LAW AND JUSTICE INQUIRY: PUBLIC HEARING IN CANBERRA, WEDNESDAY, 9 JUNE

Parliament's Public Accounts and Audit Committee will begin a program of public hearings into Indigenous Law and Justice on Wednesday, 9 June in Committee Room 1R1, Parliament House, Canberra.

The Committee will hear from witnesses, including Commonwealth Government agencies, an Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander Legal Service and the Human Rights and Equal Opportunity Commission.

Public Accounts and Audit Committee Chairman, Mr Bob Charles MP, said "during the morning the Committee will take evidence from key Commonwealth Government agencies with responsibilities for the funding of Indigenous specific legal and family violence prevention services. Later in the day, we will hear from a provider of legal services to Indigenous Australians and other interested parties."

"This is the first hearing in a program that will see the Committee take evidence on the provision of legal services to Indigenous people in urban centres around the country. The Committee will also travel to regional and remote communities."

Further hearings will be held in Sydney on 13 July, in Darwin on 21 July and in Alice Springs on 22 July.
