ENQIRY INTO AUSTRALIA'S RELATIONSHIP WITH THE COUNTRIES OF AFRICA Updated Student Statistics

In Australia, African students comprise around 2% per cent of international student numbers. The number of students in Australia on student visas from Sub-Saharan Africa has grown from 4414 in 2002 to 8934 (relatively evenly divided between higher education and vocational education and training) at February 2010. Around thirty countries have no or single digit student numbers in Australia, while four countries have between ten and twenty students. Numbers for other countries include Malawi (89 students); Ghana (87); Seychelles (72); Tanzania (137); Nigeria (267); Zambia (621); South Africa (730); Kenya (1625); Zimbabwe (1519) and Mauritius (3284).

In North Africa, the AEI Consul is accredited to Libya and Egypt from where there are 256 and 1048 students respectively. To our knowledge there are no government to government education and training Memorandum of Understanding (MoUs) with any African country.
