Inquiry into Trade and Investment Relations with Asia, the Pacific and Latin America – Public Hearing

The Joint Standing Committee on Foreign Affairs, Defence and Trade is conducting an inquiry into Australia's Trade and Investment Relations with Asia, the Pacific and Latin America.

Janelle Saffin, Chair of the Trade Sub-Committee, said that "the aim of the inquiry is to find ways to further expand Australia's trade and investment opportunities in countries that already account for three-quarters of Australia's total trade."

Trade and investment in these regions are issues of growing importance to Australia and the inquiry is seeking ways to help Australian companies, particularly those in regional areas, make the most of current and developing opportunities. Australia has had a close and long-standing association with the Pacific Island countries generally, and the members of the South Pacific Forum in particular.

On Wednesday 28 October, the Sub-Committee will hold a further Public Hearing. It will hear evidence from the Pacific Islands Trade Commissioner. The Sub-Committee is pleased to have this opportunity, as the Australian Government has been a strong supporter of the Pacific Islands Trade Commission since it was established.

The hearing will be held in Committee Room 1 S 5 commencing at 11:00am and concluding at about 12:15pm.
