## *Human rights in our neighbourhood*: Public hearing in Sydney

The parliamentary Human Right Sub-Committee is heading to Sydney on Wednesday, 18 February 2009 to meet with human rights groups to discuss protecting human rights in Asia and the Pacific.

The absence of a regional mechanism in the Asia-Pacific to prevent and redress human rights violations makes this area a natural focus for the Committee's examination of human rights mechanisms.

Sub-Committee Chair, Ms Kerry Rea MP said, "Whether or not the region is currently ready, willing or able to set up such a framework, it is worthwhile to look at what is happening in our region. It is useful to look at what protections are in place to assist people whose human rights are being violated, and what part Australia can play in offering support to our neighbours as they strive to address human rights situations".
