

Expanding Australia's trade and investment relations with the Gulf States

First public hearing: Monday 29 March 2004 Canberra

As part of its inquiry into **Expanding Australia's trade and investment relations with the Gulf States**, the Trade Sub-Committee of the Joint Standing Committee on Foreign Affairs Defence and Trade will hold the first of four public hearings this coming Monday 29 March in Canberra.

The inquiry was established to examine and report on ways to expand Australia's trade and investment relationship with the economies of the Gulf States (Bahrain, Kuwait, Oman, Saudi Arabia, the United Arab Emirates, Qatar and Iran), paying particular attention to:

- The nature of Australia's existing trade and investment relationships with the region;
- Likely future trends in these relationships; and
- The role of Government, particularly the Department of Foreign Affairs and Trade (DFAT), Austrade and the Export Finance and Insurance Corporation (EFIC), in identifying and assisting Australian companies to maximise opportunities in the Gulf States as they emerge.

Following the Canberra hearing, further hearings will be held in Sydney and Melbourne—both on 7 April—and a final hearing will be held in June (details to be advised).
