Australia's international research and development relationships will be on the agenda at a public hearing of the Standing Committee on Foreign Affairs, Defence and Trade committee.

The Trade Sub-Committee will discuss the latest collaborations with Japan and South Korea with the Department of Innovation, Industry, Science and Research in Canberra on Wednesday.
