Farmers and agencies have their say on North Asia trade

The National Farmers' Federation, the Embassy of the Republic of Korea and key government agencies will join the discussion on Australia's trade and investment relations with Japan and the Republic of Korea at two public hearings in Canberra.

Trade between Australia and the north Asian giants is worth more than \$78 billion annually, making Japan and South Korea Australia's second and fourth largest trading partners respectively.

The chair of the Trade Sub-Committee of the Joint Standing Committee on Foreign Affairs, Defence and Trade, Ms Janelle Saffin, said the inquiry is important for Australia's economic future.

"It is important for Australia's productivity to ensure that we build on our already strong trading partnerships with these two countries and look at the role of the government in identifying new opportunities and assisting Australian companies to access existing and potential opportunities," Ms Saffin said.
