## Federal government departments on growing trade with Mexico and the region

Federal government departments will discuss growing trade with Mexico and its neighbours with the Trade Sub-Committee on Friday 22 June in Canberra.

This will be the Trade Committee's final public hearing for its inquiry into Australia's trade with Mexico and the region.

The Chair of the Trade Committee Bruce Baird said "The Trade Committee is anxious to hear from these departments so that they may inform the Committee as to the various government initiatives in dealing with Mexico and the region."

Mr Baird said that he was "particularly interested in evidence from the Department of Transport and Regional Services as the Committee would like to see more direct flights between Australia and Mexico."
