Australia's \$766m in aid to the Pacific

Parliament to host a roundtable on 27 November

Australia's \$766 million Pacific aid program will be on the agenda when federal parliament's Human Rights Sub-Committee hosts a roundtable with Pacific Island High Commissioners at Parliament House on Monday 27 November from 10:45 am -12 noon.

The public hearing by the Joint Standing Committee on Foreign Affairs, Defence and Trade follows on from the Committee's hearing in Brisbane last month where Australia's aid program was discussed with academics and consultants with extensive experience in the region.

At this hearing, the Committee will hear from Australia's peak body for Non-Government Organisations - the Australian Council for International Development, and from Transparency International Australia.

The Chair of the Sub-Committee, Senator Marise Payne, said:

"The current inquiry is an opportunity to continue to discuss ways to meet the challenges and opportunities for aid in our region, and the Committee is particularly looking forwards to discussions with our Pacific partners."

In September 2005, Prime Minister John Howard announced a doubling of Australia's aid budget to \$4 billion by 2010. Subsequently, AusAID published its first White Paper on aid which will guide the direction and delivery of the Australian aid program over the next 10 years.
