Inquiry into care of Australian Defence Force personnel wounded and injured on operations

Public Hearing on Monday 25 March

On Monday, several organisations assisting with the rehabilitation of Australian Defence Force (ADF) members wounded and injured on operations will appear at a public hearing in Brisbane of the parliamentary inquiry into their care.

Defence Sub-Committee chair Senator Mark Furner said that the Joint Standing Committee on Foreign Affairs, Defence and Trade had heard much about the many programs which support the rehabilitation of ADF personal wounded on operations in Afghanistan and other places.

"A good proportion of Queensland-based military personnel have deployed on operations in recent years, and unfortunately not all have come home in one piece," Senator Furner said. "The best possible recovery of these troops from their injuries is clearly of paramount importance, and this is an opportunity for some Queensland agencies that are supporting Queensland Diggers in their recovery to discuss some of the successes, issues and challenges that they have encountered".
