Answer

The Australian Communications and Media Authority (ACMA) monitors broadcasters' compliance with Australian content and regional local content obligations. This monitoring includes regular review of compliance data submitted by broadcasters and investigation of complaints and other enquiries about potential non-compliance.

The ACMA also publishes compliance data in relation to both Australian content and regional local content.
