## Re: Support for Constitutional Recognition of Local Government

I am writing in support of the Australian Local Government Association's (ALGA) case to have Local Government Australia wide recognised in the Australian Constitution.

I wish to reinforce Council's position from its letter to the Prime Minister dated 7 April 2011 where it advised that a resolution was passed by Council on 23 March 2011 whereby –

"Banana Shire Council declares its support for financial recognition of local government in the Australian Constitution so that the Federal Government has the power to fund local government directly and also for inclusion of local government in any new Preamble to the Constitution if one is proposed, and calls on all political parties to support a referendum by 2013 to change the Constitution to achieve this recognition."

Further, I would take this opportunity to confirm that -

- Council supports the Federal Government having power to be able to provide funding directly to Local Government where this is the national interest;
- Council needs certainty of funding so that programs like Roads to Recovery can continue;
- Council supports an amendment to Section 96 of the Constitution so that it reads: "Parliament may grant financial assistance to any state or local body formed by or under law of a state or territory";
- Bi-partisan support is an essential precondition if a referendum is to have the best chance of success;
- Council supports the referendum being held at a time which maximises its chance of success;

• Council supports a publicly funded national education and awareness campaign to inform the public about the Constitution, how to change it, and about the question being asked before the referendum.
