

JOINT STANDING COMMITTEE ON TREATIES PUBLIC HEARING INTO TREATIES TABLED ON 12 MARCH 2002

13 proposed international treaties to be probed

Parliament's Treaties Committee is to hold public hearings into 13 proposed international treaties which were tabled in the Federal Parliament on 12 March 2002.

The public hearings, which will be with senior public servants from across the eight Federal Government Departments advocating the treaties, will occur this Monday, 13 May, in Committee Room 2R1 at Parliament House, Canberra.
