



Treaties hearing on the Kyoto Protocol

The Federal Parliament's Treaties Committee will hear evidence in Canberra on Monday 10 November on two treaties: the Agreement between Australia and the Republic of Finland on Social Security, tabled on 16 September; and the Kyoto Protocol, tabled on 25 June 2008.
