Purpose of the Report

- 1.1 This report contains advice to Parliament on the review by the Joint Standing Committee on Treaties of one treaty action tabled in Parliament on 16 September 2008:1
 - Agreement between Australia and the Republic of Finland on Social Security (Helsinki, 10 September 2008)
- 1.2 The Report refers frequently to the National Interest Analysis (NIA) prepared for the proposed treaty action. This document is prepared by the Government agency or agencies responsible for the administration of Australia's responsibilities under each treaty.
