JOINT STANDING COMMITTEE

BETWEEN AUSTRALIA & REPUBLIC
OF CHINA, ON SENTENCED PERSONS.
DEAR SIR.

IT IS THE SUBMISSION OF THIS EXECUTIVE THAT THIS TREATY BE RATIFIED, HOWEVER WE DO NOT SUPPORT THE TRANSFER OF PERSONS WHO COMMIT SERIOUS OFFENCES.

THE RECENT HANGING OF AN AUSTRALIAN CITIZEN IN SINGAPORE
WAS JUSTIFIED, PERSONS WHO FLEE JUSTICE, SHOULD BE RETURNED TO
FACE COURTS. PEOPLE WHO COMMIT ANY MAJOR OFFENCE SHOULD FACE
PUNISHMENT IN THAT COUNTRY, WITHOUT ANY ASSISTANCE FROM THE
COUNTRY OF ORIGIN. WE DO NOT SUPPORT DRUGS OR DRUG DEALERS,
AS WE DO NOT HAVE THE DEATH PENALTY IN AUSTRALIA, WE SUPPORT
NATIONS WHO ARE NOT AFRAID TO EXECUTE THESE ANIMALS. OTHER
CRIMES SUCH AS CHILD MOLESTATION, RAPE, ARE HANDLED BY THE
REPUBLIC OF CHINA, AND OTHERS IN A MANNER MORE IN LINE WITH
THE POLICY OF THIS EXECUTIVE MINOR OFFENCES, OR PERSONS THAT
ARE INVOLVED IN TERRORIST ACTIVITY, WHITE COLLAR CRIME, SHOULD
FACE AUSTRALIAN COURTS.

CAPITAL PUNISHMENT SHOULD BE INTRODUCED FOR TERRORISM, DRUG OR HUMAN TRAFFICKING, CHILD MOLESTATION, WE ARE NOT SERIOUS ABOUT LAW IF THE CRIME IS NOT FOLLOWED UP BY A PUNISHMENT FITTING OF THAT OFFENCE.

THE ROLE OF THE PARLIAMENT IS PROTECTION OF TH AUSTRALIAN SOCIETY, IT IS TIME THAT ROLE IS ENACTED, THE PEOPLE LOOK TO THE PARLIAMENT FOR LEADERSHIP, ITS TIME TO PUT EMOTION ASIDE AND REALITY IN PLAC THE EXECUTIVE WISH TO THANK THE COMMITTEE FOR ALLOWING US TO COMMENT ON THIS TREATY.
