As a nation we Australians pride ourselves on being inclusive of others which is how we got started on the multiculturalism roller coaster. That is all very well if those who we accept are accepting of us and our values. In my experience and observation of Muslim communities however the opposite is true. They generally do not integrate, They generally do not respect us or our laws, They work together to undermine our society by lobbying for the introduction of their own [Sharia] laws to the detriment of our society.

I do not wish to condemn all Muslims but the high profile representatives of their society seem to influence the rest in a way that suggests coercion. Once again I think it is time to rethink who we allow to share our home with us and what they are likely to do in our midst.
