## **Finding Skilled Migrants**

I refer to your letter of 14 October 2002 and advise that under the Local Government Act, Council is required to advertise vacancies "in a manner sufficient to enable suitably qualified persons to apply for the position". Within this context, Council advertises in a range of newspapers.

Based on the above premise, Council is able to attract sufficient suitably qualified applicants for most vacancies.

Council policy requires that all appointments be made on a merit basis, and this has enabled Council to employ a number of staff who were born overseas, or who come from a NESB.

In order to foster the development of career opportunities for migrants, Council has also participated in the Skilled Migrant Placement Programme via a local community organisation.

Council does not believe that it has experienced any particular problems in attracting suitably skilled "migrants" to its workforce.
