## National Capital Authority to appear before the NCET Committee 12.30pm - 1.30pm, Wednesday, 23 November 2011

The National Capital Committee will question the National Capital Authority (NCA) at a public hearing on Wednesday, 22 June 2011 from 12.30 to 1.30pm in Committee Room 2S3, Parliament House, Canberra.

The hearings are a means of raising the level of transparency and parliamentary accountability applying to the NCA.

The NCA manages the Commonwealth's interest in the planning and development of Canberra and the Territory by administering the National Capital Plan (NCP) and areas designated as National Lands.

This hearing will provide an opportunity for the committee to ask the NCA about proposals for a new diplomatic estate in Canberra.
