

## NCET Committee to examine issues affecting Australia's Indian Ocean Territories

## 12.45pm - 1.30pm, Wednesday, 28 November 2012

The National Capital and External Territories Committee will question the Department of Regional Australia, Local Government, Arts and Sport about current developments in Australia's Indian Ocean Territories at a public hearing on Wednesday, 28 November 2012 from 12.45 to 1.45 pm in **Committee Room 2S1**, Parliament House, Canberra.

Review of policies affecting the Indian Ocean Territories is an important part of the Committees role. This hearing will provide an opportunity for the Committee to follow up with the Department on a number of issues raised by the communities on Christmas Island and the Cocos (Keeling) Islands during the Committee's recent visit to the Indian Ocean Territories.

Committee Chair, Senator Louise Pratt, stated that the communities on the islands had raised a significant number of important issues with the Committee which needed to be addressed. "In particular, community members highlighted the impact on the island communities of the influx of boat arrivals, and the stresses this placed on local resources," she said.

The hearings will provide an opportunity to canvass these issues and point the way to possible solutions in the interests of the local communities and the Australian community as a whole.
