Farming the Future

- Media Conference next Tuesday -

The House of Representatives Primary Industries and Resources Committee will unveil its proposals to assist Australian farmers in adapting to climate change when it releases its report, **Farming the Future: the role of government in assisting Australian farmers to adapt to the impacts of climate change**, next Monday night (15 March) at **8:40pm**.

The report addresses a range of issues surrounding the adaptation of our agricultural industries to the impacts of climate change, especially the range of innovations already being undertaken in response to climate variability. It also examines the importance of soil carbon to our farming future, the need to address social and attitudinal factors as well as economic and environmental ones, and the importance of supporting local and community level organisations in helping farming communities adapt and become more resilient. The report will address the role of government in supporting research into climate change adaptations.
