More Than Honey

The House of Representatives Primary Industries and Resources Committee will unveil proposals to reinvigorate the Australian honey bee and pollination industries when it releases its report, **More Than Honey: the future of the Australian honey bee and pollination industries**, next Monday night (16 June) at **8:30pm**.

The report addresses concerns about the increasing challenges facing the industry and pollination dependent industries in the face of biosecurity threats, such as the bee mite *Varroa destructor*, declining access to floral resources, and the economic challenges facing the industry. The report also addresses the research and training needs of the industry that plays a key role for Australia's multi-billion dollar agricultural sector.
