## **Review of the Relisting: Hizballah's External Security Organisation (ESO)**

Section 102.1A of the *Criminal Code Act 1995* requires the Parliamentary Joint Committee on Intelligence and Security to review a regulation listing a terrorist organisation as soon as possible after the making of the regulation and to report the committee's comments and recommendations to each House of the Parliament before the end of the applicable disallowance period, a period of 15 sitting days from the tabling of the regulation.

On 7 May 2007, the Attorney-General informed the committee of his intention to relist Hizballah's External Security Organisation (ESO) as a terrorist organisation for the purposes of section 102.1 of the *Criminal Code Act 1995*.

Organisations or individuals who have information relevant to this listing are invited to make written submissions to the committee. The committee will accept submissions up to **Friday 22 June 2007**.
