

Parliamentary review of Australia's terrorism laws

The Parliamentary Joint Committee on Intelligence and Security will meet next week with Simon Sheller, who recently reviewed Australian terrorism laws in the Sheller Report.

The Committee is conducting a review of the operation, effectiveness and implications of terrorism legislation and also the recommendations of the Sheller Report.
