Submission Regarding Australian Security Legislation

We understand that the Parliamentary Joint Committee on Intelligence and Security is currently conducting a review of various acts relating to terrorism. As the Committee may be aware, the Federation of Community Legal Centres appeared as a witness in the Sheller Inquiry. To assist this Committee's review we therefore enclose the following:

1. Our written submission to the Sheller Inquiry regarding the

- Security Legislation Amendment (Terrorism) Act 2002 (Cth);
- Suppression of Financing of Terrorism Act 2002 (Cth); and
- Criminal Code Amendment (Terrorism) Act 2003 (Cth)

2. Our submission on the recommendations of the Sheller Inquiry.

The Federation of Community Legal Centres Vic. Inc ('the Federation') is the peak body for fiftytwo Community Legal Centres ('CLC's') across Victoria, including both generalist and specialist centres. The above submissions have been prepared on behalf of the Federation by its Anti-Terrorism Laws Working Group, in consultation with various other members of the Federation.

The Anti-Terrorism Laws Working Group is one of a number of issue-specific working groups within the Federation comprising workers from member centres. The Working Group also works to monitor the impact of State and Commonwealth anti-terrorism laws on affected communities and individuals.
