Inquiry into future water supplies for Australia's rural industries and communities

Public hearings in Queensland, 17 – 19 February 2003

The House of Representatives Agriculture Committee is examining the role of the Commonwealth in ensuring an adequate and sustainable future water supply for communities and industries in rural and regional Australia.

As part of its inquiry, the Committee will visit south east Queensland next week to gather evidence from local government, landowners and water management authorities.

Committee Chair, Mrs Kay Elson MP, says the inquiry has generated considerable interest around Australia, with 130 submissions received from concerned organisations and individuals.

"Getting water management right, so that water is available when and where it is needed on a sustainable basis, is crucial not only for the prosperity of rural Australia, but the nation as a whole," Mrs Elson said.

"We cannot afford, as a nation, to manage water in an ineffective, inefficient or cumbersome way."
