National Conference of Parliamentary Environment and Public Works Committees

- 4.1 The Eleventh Annual Conference of Parliamentary Environment and Public Works Committees was hosted by the Public Works Committee of the Queensland Parliament. It was held in Brisbane and Cairns from 24 to 27 July 2006.
- 4.2 The conference was attended by delegates from the relevant parliamentary committees of the Commonwealth, and of all Australian States and Territories. International delegates included members of the New Zealand Local Government and Environment Committee.
- 4.3 The Committee was represented at the conference by Deputy Chair Mr Brendan O'Connor MP and Senator Stephen Parry.
- 4.4 The theme of the 2006 conference was *Ecotourism and developing infrastructure in environmentally sensitive areas*. The programme included addresses by:
