Kennels

- Separate metering for the kennels
- Zoned switching for lighting and heating

Training Rooms/ office space

- Lighting no more than 10 watts per m2 maximum
- Separate metering for tenant light and power and (central service if applicable)
- Zoned switching every 250 m² and energy efficient lighting controls

AGO has held discussions with the AFP appreciates their efforts to achieve energy efficiency measures in relation to this facility.
