Marriage Equality and Marriage Amendment Bills Public Hearing in Sydney

The Marriage Equality Amendment Bill 2012 and the Marriage Amendment Bill 2012 will be in the spotlight this week, with a public hearing to be held in Sydney this Thursday (12 April 2012).

Both bills seek to repeal the definition of marriage and substitute the words "a man and a woman" with the words "two people", and to recognise same-sex marriages conducted overseas.

Chair of the House of Representatives Social Policy and Legal Affairs Committee, Graham Perrett MP, said the committee will meet with a range of people and groups to discuss the bills.

"This is an important issue and many individuals and groups want to have their say," Mr Perrett said.

"It's also vital that we explore the relevant legal issues, such as the parliament's marriage power and the legal ramifications of the proposed amendments."

Religious bodies, lawyers, celebrants, human rights organisations and advocacy groups will be represented at the public hearing.
