THE BIG BARRIER'. IS ISOLATION FROM THE COMMUNITY - CARING FOR A DISABLED PERSON IS FULL TIME -MY SON BECOMES FRUSTRATED AND UPSET WHEN HE HAS TO MOVE OUT OF HIS POUTING THIS MEANS HE DOES NOT LIKE SOCIALISING . HOLIDAYS WITHOUT ME TO CALM HIM ARE FOOT POSSIBLE A BIC BARRIER FOR HOLIDAYS IS THE LACK OF SUPPORTED ACCOMMODATION FOR TWO \_ SUCH AS A SELF CONTAINED CABIN-IN A HOLIDAY LOCATION. · OPPORTUNITIES FOR PART TIME EMPLOYMENT IN A SHELTERED ENVIRONMENT ARE LIMITED FOR THE DISABLED. CARERS ARE NOT PRIESENTED WITH CHOICES AUBILABLE TO GENERATE EXTRA INCOME. WITHOUT AFFECTING THEIR PENSION ALLOWANCE . AS CARERS REACH THE AGE OF 80 YEARS THE CARING SITUATION IS FRAUCHT WITH GREATER PROLEMS FOR EXAMPLE: I SUFFER FROM ANCINA. DIABETES 2. ARTHRITIS. I AM LECALLY BLAD YET. WHEN I APPLIED FOR ASSISTANCE ! FOUND I WAS TOLD MY SON COULD NOT BE PLACED ON A "PRIORITY" LIST FOR HOUSING - OR "FUNDING FOR DISABILITY SUPPORT" · ALTHOUGH THE SUBMISSIONS WERE ACCEPTED THESE DO NOT RECEIVE A PRIORITY RATING. A "PRIORITY" RATING FOR THE DISABLED, WHO ARE BEING CARED FOR - BY A FATILY MEMBER OVER SO YEARS OLD. SHOULD BE GRANTED.

1 PARTICULARLY NEED HELP NOW 1 AM 81 YEARS OLD. I NEED TO HAVE TRANSITIONAL AID WHEN RELINQUISING MY ROLE AS A CARER. . THIS TRANSITIONAL PERIOD IS CONFRONTATIONAL IN 2007 MY SON INDICATED HE WOULD LIKE TO TRY LIVING INDEPENDENTLY AN APPLICATION WAS MADE FOR HIM TO OBTAIN A UNIT. THIS APPLICATION WAS GRANTED AND HE WAS PLACED ON A WAITING LIST. HE WAS REFUSED 'HIGH PRIDRITY" RATING. BECAUSE OF ME BEING 1415 CARER! YET I AM 81. AND MY DAYS OF CARING ARE DRAWING TO A CLOSE- (MAY EVEN BE OVER WHEN THIS IS READ) . IT WOULD HAVE HELPED ME HAD I BEEN ABLE TO SUPPORT MY SON THROUGH THIS TRANSITIONAL STAGE-AND EASED MY MIND. . IN 2007 - MY SON APPLIED FOR" DISABILITY SUPPORT" HIS APPLICATION WAS APPROVED HOWEVER AGAIN HE WAS NOT GIVEN "PRIDRITY" - BUT ONLY "WHEN RESOURCES BECAME AUNILABLE - I WAS REGRETFLEY TOLD THIS COULD INVOLUE A LONG WAITING" PERIOD - I AND MANY OTHER ELDERLY CARERS HAVE GIVEN THEIR ENTIRE LIVES TO CARING NOW WE ARE GETTING CLOSE TO HEAVENS DOOR" WE NEED HELP URGENTLY. TO ENSURE WE LEAVE OUR CHARGES IN THE BEST CARE AVAILABLE. DN A LESSER PRIORITY - I WOULD HAVE APPECINTED SOME HELP WITH MY GARDEN. IT WAS MY MAIN PLEASURE NOW. I CANNOT AFFORD TO PAY A GARDENED TO DO
