The Hon Bronwyn Bishop MP asked:

We had evidence from DIMA earlier that they have established a purchasing assurance committee, and DOFA is a member of that committee. Do other departments have a similar purchasing assurance committee or is this something that has been created in DIMA because of their failure on the GSL contract?

Answer:

Responsibility for procurement is devolved to the Chief Executive of each agency. Australian Government agencies use a range of governance and probity mechanisms when undertaking procurement. Any questions on DIMA procurement should be directed to DIMA.
