At the JCPAA hearing into the Management and Integrity of Electronic Information in the Commonwealth on 17 October, I took several questions on notice.

Those questions and the responses are as follows:

- what inquiries are currently occurring within Customs and within the government, as opposed to police inquiries, concerning the theft of computer equipment from Customs' premises in Mascot?
  - The two inquiries in which EDS has participated are being conducted by the Defence Signals Directorate and by Mr Stevenson and Mr Allen
- What staff turnover does EDS have?
  - o EDS' Australia's staff turnover is between 8 and 9 per cent
- Is the highest level of security of data held by EDS for Customs "highly protected"?
  - o Yes
- How often does EDS review the security checks undertaken on its personnel?
