At the Council meeting held on 20 December 2012, correspondence with regard to the progress of constitutional recognition for local government was considered.

Council resolved as follows:

- 01/12 <u>**RESOLVED</u>** by Councillor Culhane and Councillor Barlow that Council:</u>
 - 1. Requests that the Federal Government recognise financial recognition for local government in the Australian Constitution as per resolution 97/11 for the Upper Lachlan Shire Council Meeting held 17 March 2011.
 - 2. Support the Federal Government having the power to provide funding directly to Local Government where this is in the national interest.
 - 3. Reinforces the need for certainty of funding so that programs such as Roads to Recovery can continue to benefit the community.
 - 4. Supports an amendment to Section 96 of the Constitution, "Parliament may grant financial assistance to any State or Local Government body formed by or under a law of a State or Territory".
 - 5. Highlights that bi-partisan support is an essential pre-condition if a referendum is to have any chance of success.

- 6. Supports the referendum being held at a time that maximises its chance of success.
- 7. Supports a publicly funded national education and awareness campaign to inform the public about the Constitution, how to change it and about the question being asked before the referendum.
