# Introduction

## Purpose of the report

1.1 This Report contains advice to Parliament on the review by the Joint Standing Committee on the Agreement between the Government of Australia and the Government of the Hong Kong Special Administrative Region of the People's Republic of China concerning Transfer of Sentenced Persons, done at Hong Kong on 25 November 2005. The treaty action was tabled in Parliament on 29 November 2005.<sup>1</sup>
