## Provision of amenity within the Parliamentary Triangle

The National Capital Committee has commenced a new inquiry into the provision of amenity within the Parliamentary Triangle. Since its inception, the Parliamentary Triangle has become home to a large number of workplaces engaged in a range of public and private enterprises. This has led to a change in the working environment of the precinct.

The Committee is to inquire into and report on the provision of amenity within the Parliamentary Triangle, with particular reference to:

1. Describing the changing nature of the working environment in the Parliamentary Triangle;
2. The adequacy of the retail services available in this precinct against the benchmark of like employment precincts located in the Capital; and
3. Should these services be considered inadequate, recommend steps that would ameliorate that inadequacy.
