Inquiry into pay parking in the Parliamentary Zone

The Federal Parliament's National Capital Committee is conducting an inquiry into proposals for Pay Parking in the Parliamentary Zone.

The introduction of pay parking in the Parliamentary Zone is part of a proposed group of initiatives for the long-term development of the Parliamentary Zone, as set out in the Parliamentary Zone Review Outcomes Report released by the National Capital Authority in March 2000.

Under the Committee's Terms of Reference the inquiry will examine the potential effects of pay parking on:

- the interests of visitors to the Parliamentary Zone;
- the interests of those employed in the Parliamentary Zone and adjacent areas;
- the interests of the national institutions in the Parliamentary Zone:
- tourism and related issues; and

 proposed parking policies for Forrest and Barton - areas adjacent to the Parliamentary Zone managed by the ACT Government - and the effects of these policies on parking arrangements in the Parliamentary Zone.
