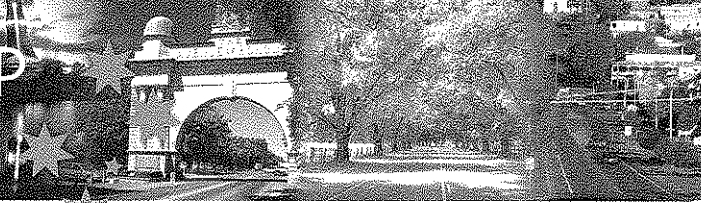

My husband Mr Mark Francis Karlovic has recently accepted an appointment as Regional Human Resources Manager with International Power Australia GDF Suez.

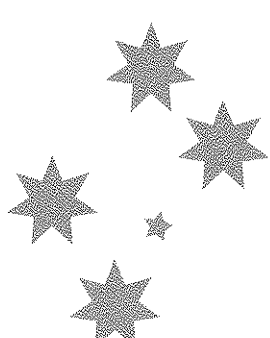

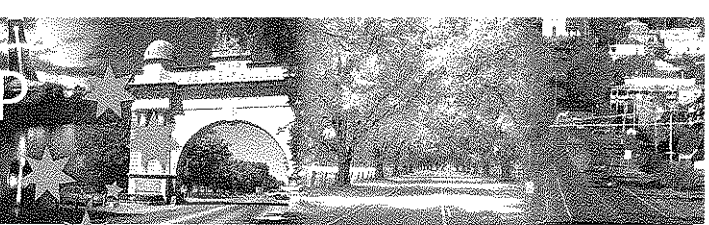
