Witnesses will brief the committee on a diverse range of topics and issues, from the Australian Cotton Cooperative Research Centre's approach to research and education, to the challenges faced by the important honeybee industry.

The committee chair, Alby Schultz (Member for Hume, NSW), said "the committee has received numerous submissions from northern NSW and we see this as an opportunity to hear about some of the developments in NSW regarding rural training, skills and research".
