Public 'round table' in Deniliquin NSW, Thursday 31 July 2003

Irrigator groups to appear at inquiry into future water supplies: access, trading, efficiency, savings and environment on agenda

The House of Representatives Agriculture Committee is examining the role of the Commonwealth in ensuring adequate and sustainable future water supplies for communities and industries in rural and regional Australia.

On **Thursday 31 July** the committee will hold a public 'round table' hearing with representatives of seven groups representing irrigators in the Deniliquin region of NSW. These groups are:

- Coleambally Irrigation Cooperative;
- Irrigators Inc;
- Moira Private Irrigation District;
- Murray Valley Groundwater Users Assoc;
- Murray Irrigation;
- Murrumbidgee Irrigation; and
- Southern Riverina Irrigation Districts Council.

The 'round table' will focus on the following four key issues:

- Water access rights and water trading
- Environmental flows and the 'Living Murray'
- Efficiency of water use and potential savings
- Future research requirements.

The House of Representatives Agriculture Committee Chair, Mrs Kay Elson MP, says the inquiry has generated considerable interest around Australia, with more than 160 submissions received from concerned organisations and individuals.

"Getting water management right, which includes the balance of allocations between different users, is crucial not only for the prosperity of rural Australia, but the nation as a whole," Mrs Elson said.
