## Teacher education inquiry to visit University of Wollongong

The House of Representatives Education and Vocational Training Committee will visit the University of Wollongong on the south coast of NSW tomorrow as part of the Committee's major inquiry into teacher education.

"An emerging focus of this inquiry is the way in which universities, schools and governments work together to address teacher education issues," said Committee Chair Luke Hartsuyker.

"We are quite keen to hear about the University of Wollongong's partnerships, particularly in regards to the practicum component of teacher education."

In order to explore these issues, representatives from some of the University of Wollongong's partner schools will appear before the Committee to give evidence, in addition to the university's own representatives.

The University of Wollongong's submission is one of over 160 submissions the Committee has received from across Australia. The Committee held public hearings in the ACT, Victoria, Queensland, South Australia, the Northern Territory, Western Australia and Tasmania during 2005. The Committee has also held a number of hearings in the ACT and New South Wales in early 2006.
