Army Expansion facilities under parliamentary scrutiny

The Public Works Committee is conducting an inquiry into the proposed Enhanced Land Force Stage 2 Facilities, Gallipoli Barracks, Enoggera other Defence sites in Australia.

The \$1.4 billion project proposes to provide working and living accommodation for the 8th/9th Battalion RAR and other elements of the 7th Brigade, as well as facilities for collective training, career training and logistic support. The primary location for the works is the Gallipoli Barracks in Enoggera (Brisbane), and other works will be undertaken in 11 other Defence bases and training areas across five states and territories.

The Public Works Committee is responsible for ensuring that the need, cost and scope proposed is appropriate.

The Committee will be holding a public hearing with the Department of Defence on the proposal at **1pm** on **Wednesday 4 November 2009**.
