SUBMISSION TO PUBLIC WORKS INQUIRY - AUSTRALIAN INSTITUTE OF POLICE MANAGEMENT REDEVELOPMENT, NORTH HEAD, MANLY, NSW

I am writing this submission in support of the redevelopment of the Australian Institute of Police Management site at North Head, Manly, New South Wales.
