Public Works Committee to examine the Christmas Island new housing program

The Public Works Committee is set to conduct an inquiry into the Christmas Island New Housing Program. The Department of Regional Australia, Regional Development and Local Government is seeking approval from the Committee to proceed with phases two and three of the housing program, having already received approval to proceed with the first phase, the construction of 16 dwellings.

The Department says the new housing program will address a critical housing shortage on Christmas Island, as the population increases in response to an escalation in immigration activity. The construction of a further 16 new dwellings as part of projects two and three would reduce pressure on the rental market and house essential staff required for the provision of essential policing, health, education and administration services. Cabinet approved funding of \$26.6 million over three years to enable the Department to address the housing shortfall on Christmas Island.

The Committee's Chair, Janelle Saffin MP, said the Committee inspected the housing program sites when it visited Christmas Island in June 2011.

"The Committee received a detailed briefing from the Department when it inspected the proposed housing sites on Christmas Island. We are pleased with the progress of the housing project and look forward to hearing further from the Department about projects two and three", Ms Saffin said.

Submissions to the inquiry close on Friday, 16 December 2011.

The Committee will be holding a public hearing on the next stages of the Christmas Island housing program early next year. Details of the hearing will be announced soon.
