Inquiry into regional aviation in Australia

Public hearings in Adelaide and Kangaroo Island, Monday 14 April – Wednesday 16 April 2003

The House of Representatives Transport and Regional Services Committee is examining the adequacy of regional aviation services and transport links to Australia's major populated islands.

The Committee will visit **Adelaide** and **Kangaroo Island** next week to gather evidence from government, airline operators and airport owners.

House Transport Committee Chair, Mr Paul Neville MP, said the inquiry has generated considerable interest around Australia with 168 submissions received from interested organisations and individuals.

"While the community and industry in larger centres are well served by the current arrangements, services could be improved to a number of regional centres, particularly those in remote Australia. Key issues are costs and returns, service levels, interconnectivity between services, regulation and coordination," Mr Neville said.
