Community Television: Options For Digital Broadcasting

Options for digital broadcasting for community television are discussed in a new report to be released on Monday 12 February 2007 by the House of Representatives Standing Committee on Communications, Information Technology and the Arts.

Report Release

The report is due to be tabled on Monday 12 February in the House of Representatives by Committee Chair, Jackie Kelly, at approximately 12.35pm. The Deputy Chair, Julie Owens, will also provide a tabling statement.

The inquiry into community broadcasting was announced in January 2006. The Committee received 130 submissions and public hearings were conducted across Australia. A second report covering broader community broadcasting issues will be released later this year.
