## Economics Committee to hear from ACCI on Service Exports and Manufacturing Inquires

The Australian Chamber of Commerce and Industry will be among the witnesses at a House Economics Committee hearing in Canberra tomorrow.

The Committee will hold a public hearing as part of its inquiry into the service export sector, and its inquiry into the manufacturing sector. The committee's inquiries, which were referred by Treasurer Peter Costello, are looking at Australia's potential economic strengths beyond the resources boom, focussing on two of the key non-mining export sectors—services and manufacturing.
