Full Stakeholder Meeting 1 - Presentation of concept design options.

Consultant designers presented revised schematic design options for Campus Place and Development Plan document to Lawrence Nield, and explained history of ellipse design being put aside etc. This was also a briefing meeting for Lawrence so that he could offer input.

Consultant designers emailed Lawrence Nield regarding possible scope of consultancy. Lawrence has not replied to this email and it has not been pursued - Consultant designers uncertain if the NCA wanted to pursue this consultancy.

NCA & consultant designer meet with Urban Art Projects in Sydney for discussions on how the new campus design might be best sympathetic to the existing and proposed Reconciliation Place artworks.

Full Stakeholder Meeting 2 - Presentation of developed Concept design, Option 4.

Eminent Person Peer Review Group Workshop. This workshop provided very positive feedback and critique to the design process. All participants were willing to re-form should it be required at the request of the NCA. A second meeting is not at this stage been considered necessary.

Consultant designers met Urban Art projects and artist Judy Watson in Brisbane for discussions on how the new campus design might be best related to one particular (major) Reconciliation Place artwork.

Presentation of developed Concept design, Option 4. At this meeting both boards advised they could not consider developing design without a satisfactory resolution to the traffic/parking issues of the area.

Concept Stage - This is in the form of an on-line & written survey in the foyers of the National Library and Questacon to allow members of public to comment on the concept design/objectives. This was announced via media release, Capital 21, and the NCA + NLA websites. Participants have been informed that this is the first part of an ongoing consultation process.

22 December 2006 Concept Stage Survey Feedback Feedback Feedback from the User Survey regarding the concept stage design became available prior to Christmas. 206 people filled out the user surveys in person in the foyer of the National Library, while 141 were completed at Questacon. 100 surveys were submitted on-line. The results showed that the users of Questacon and the NLA have divergent needs and aspirations for the area. The results will be used to inform the developing design.

21 March 2007 Presentation to NLA/Q Department Heads

Developed Design presented by consultant team to Professor Graham Durant of Questacon; Ms Jan Fullerton, and Sir James Gobbo of the NLA; and Graham Crocket of DEWR. Letters of Endorsement sought from Questacon and the NLA

All proponents from the original consultation process to be advised in writing of developed design proposals. They will be asked to provide comment within 3 weeks of receipt of letters.

4 May 2007 Presentation to Q coach drivers NCA presents proposal to Questacon coach drivers who raise a number of previously not known concerns. Minutes from Questacon awaited.

To Come: June 2007 EPBC Referral / General Public Consultation

Referral to DEWR under EPBC Act – 20 working days to assess. Assessment due back 25 May 2007. Second round of community consultation to raise awareness of the scheme and advise of developed design proposal. Similar format to Concept Stage (see above - surveys in foyers & online + media releases).
