Infrastructure Department to front Regional Australia Committee

Three Government departments are due to give evidence before the House Regional Australia Committee on Wednesday in relation to the Committee's inquiry into FIFO/DIDO workforce practices. The Department of Infrastructure and Transport is expected to discuss the challenges with data collection, infrastructure planning and housing availability for the rapidly expanding FIFO/DIDO workforce.

The Departments of Innovation, Industry, Science, Research and Tertiary Education and the Education, Employment and Workforce Relations will appear give evidence regarding initiatives in place regional education and skills development and Indigenous workforce initiatives.

The Chair, Tony Windsor MP, said 'the Commonwealth Government has a role in many aspects of education, employment and infrastructure policy and funding that has a direct impact on FIFO/DIDO affected towns. The Committee will be making sure that these initiatives are benefiting regional Australia.'
